

# How to Complete the Code of Conduct

1. Go to <http://www.idodi.org/>

2. Choose **Volunteer Code of Conduct** under the Teams and Managers
3. Go to the **Welcome** Drop Down menu on the left side of the blue horizontal bar.
4. Choose **Create a New Account**
5. Enter all the information to Create New Account Note: everything except FAX number is required
  - A. Use the controls on the left to create a new account. Controls marked with \* are required
  - B. Note that each DI Account has a unique email address. This email address and your password are needed to log into our websites.
  - C. Passwords are case sensitive and must be at least 8 characters in length.
  - D. We realize that we collect a reasonable amount of information from you. Your account may be used to buy products in ShopDI, use the services of the Resource Area, or register for Global Finals (if that is in your future).

6. Click on the **Create New Account** button at the bottom of the page
7. You should get the following message between the blue Welcome bar and gray Login bar – Steve Schorger’s account has been created. You may now log in with your email and password.
8. Login using the information you just entered and you should see the Following Welcome screen
  - A. To access most features of the Resource Area you need a DI account and you must be logged in that account.

    - I will embrace the spirit of creativity, teamwork and problem solving as the core principles of DII.
    - I will uphold the honesty, impartiality, and reputation of DII to prevent any disparagement or defamation to the organization or individuals.

- I know the core principles on which DII does business are mutual respect, fair dealing and open communication. This is the foundation for all of our transactions and interactions.
